TURN A SINGLE A4 SHEET OF PAPER INTO A SMALL-SIZED 8-PAGE BOOKLET!

ZINES ARE VERY POPULAR AND ARE A GREAT WAY OF MAKING YOUR OWN LITTLE BOOK. IT'S CHEAP, EASY AND FUN! YOU CAN WRITE AND ILLUSTRATE A STORY, OR USE WORDS OR IMAGES ON THEIR OWN. YOU COULD TRY COLLAGE - CUTTING OUT BITS AND PIECES FROM MAGAZINES AND DRAWING OVER THE TOP - THERE ARE NO RULES! ONCE YOU'VE FINISHED, YOU CAN MAKE COPIES BY FLATTENING IT OUT, PHOTOCOPYING AND FOLDING TO SHARE WITH FRIENDS, OR PUT A COPY IN YOUR LOCAL STREET LIBRARY AS A SURPRISE FOR SOMEONE TO FIND.

YOU WILL NEED

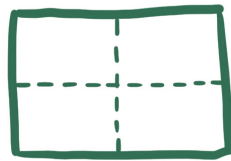
- A4 PAPER

HERE'S SOME THEMES TO GET YOU STARTED

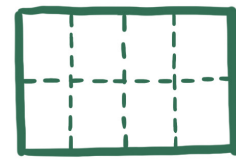
MY FAVOURITE ANIMALS

BIRDS NEAR ME



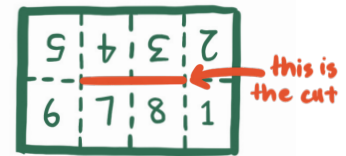
1. Fold in half both ways



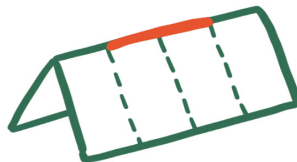
2. Fold the short sides into the middle fold



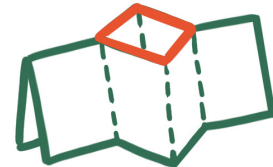
3. Fold along the middle and cut along the middle to the first fold



4. This is the page order of your zine



5. Fold in half longways



6. Pull out the middle section and push the ends in

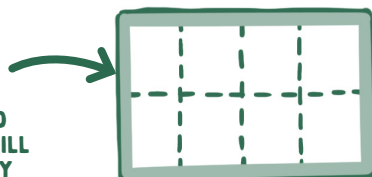


7. It will look like this



8. Fold the flaps into a book and flick through your zine!

TIP: IF YOU PLAN ON MAKING COPIES OF YOUR ZINE, LEAVE A 5MM MARGIN AROUND YOUR PAPER SO IT WILL PHOTOCOPY PROPERLY
